TECHNICAL ips cause we all have questions!

- 1. Remove air cleaner and throttle control rod.
- 2. Disconnect fuel line and vacuum spark line.
- Disconnect automatic choke control.
- 4. Remove carburetor flange bolts and carburetor from engine.

To disassemble after removal:

- Remove carburetor float cover bolts and fast idle rod.
- 2. Lift off cover.
- Remove float pin retainer spring, float and float needle.
- 4. Remove accelerator pump link

Removal and Adjustment of the Carburetor

- 5. Push out accelerator plunger assembly.
- 6. Remove economizer clip and assembly.
- Remove idle orifice plug and tube and blow out with air.
- Remove main metering screw and blow out with air.

To assemble, reverse the operations. Always use compressed air to clean carburetor jets.

Never use a drill or wire for cleaning jets.

The idle needle valve controls the fuel mixture for closed throttle running.

Turning the adjusting screw clockwise gives a leaner mixture and counter clockwise a richer mixture.
